

## Repent From The Doctrines of Men

Let us pray.

BAR-CHU et Adonai ham'vorach. Baruch Adonai ham'vorach l'olam vaed. Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha-olam, asher bacher banu mi-kol ha'amim, v'natan lanu et Torato. Baruch Atah, Adonai, notein ha Torah.

BLESS ADONAI who is blessed. Blessed is Adonai who is blessed now and forever. Blessed are You, Adonai, our God, Sovereign of the universe, who has chosen us from among the peoples, and given us the Torah. Blessed are You, Adonai, who gives the Torah.

Isaiah 40:3 A voice of one calling in the wilderness, "Prepare the way for the Lord".

We are at the end of the Last Days. We are in the days of preparation for the coming of the Messiah and the Kingdom of God on Earth. This will come about because God has proclaimed it. But God has asked me to be A Voice in The Wilderness and speak to God's people. All of God's people both Jews and Christians.

We must repent from the doctrines of men. We need to follow God and not Man.

First I will speak to the Jewish people the tribes of Judah and Benjamin those in Israel and around the world. You have followed Torah. You have remained faithful. You were scattered amongst the nations and persecuted to near extinction but you held on to the law and to the faith. Your hard service has been completed, you are returned to the land, and your sins have been paid for. But in one thing you have fallen and you must repent.

Deuteronomy 4:2 Do not add to what I command you and do not subtract from it but keep the commands of the Lord your God that I give you.

You have added to Torah. You have built fences around Torah and then built fences around the fences. You have added so many teachings of men to Torah that you have libraries full of them. Repent from the teachings of men. Turn from doctrines of old Rabbis and return to Torah alone. Messiah will not rule the nations on the teachings of men but on the law of God alone. Gods' kingdom cannot be built upon the Rabbis doctrines so repent from them.

Second, I would like to address the remaining tribes of Israel. The tribes of Reuben, Asher, Naphtali, Manasseh, Simeon, Issachar, Zebulun, Dan and Ephraim. You were hostile towards your God and rejected him and you were taken from Israel to Assyria in 709 B.C. (2 Kings 18:10,11). God appointed 390 years for your correction to bear your sin (Ezekiel 4:4,5), but you still rejected him and so according to Torah God added to your curse seven times (Leviticus 26:21) and so you have remained under his curse for 2,730 years. But as God has promised in Leviticus 26:44&45, God remembers you. Those 2,730 years came to an end and God declared an end to the curse on Yom Kippur of the Jewish year 5783 or October 4 & 5, 2022.

Isaiah 40:1,2 Comfort, comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem and proclaim to her that her hard service has been completed, that her sin has been paid for, that she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins.

And so, to the missing tribes of Israel I say, repent from the doctrines of men and return to the Land for it is time to become one with Judah again. God will go before you and he is with you.

Now I wish to speak to the Christians. You took the Gospel to the four corners of the world. You preached to every tongue and nation. You remembered the teachings of Jesus and the disciples and proclaimed them to the ends of the earth.

But you forgot the key lesson that Jesus taught his disciples was to not follow the doctrines of men. Every confrontation and every discussion that Jesus had with the religious leaders of his day was not about changing or doing away with the Old Testament Law but it was about a doctrine that was added to the Law by the Jews. It is clear that the disciples understood this lesson when Peter responded to the high priest in Acts 5:29 with, "We ought to obey God rather than men". It was not the Torah that Jesus and the disciples rejected when Christianity was founded it was the teachings of men.

And yet now some 2,000 years later Christianity has been built upon so many doctrines, myths and concepts of men that the Torah is no longer recognizable in the Church except as 'The Ten Commandments'. The Church has even rejected the Sabbath in place of a tradition of man about Sunday.

There is much talk going around about another outpouring of the Holy Spirit like happened with the Jesus People. And in these very last of days God will be pouring out his Spirit to prepare the way for his kingdom. But the Jesus People Revolution had to happen first outside the church because there were too many doctrines of men floating around within it for the Spirit to be free. So, it started with those who had no doctrines or training at all.

Christians, Pastors, Ministers, Preachers, all who yearn for God's Spirit and the full truth of what God is doing. . . Repent from the doctrines of men. If you would have the fullness of God's desire for man.

Repent from the doctrines of men.

Turn Away from the Doctrines of Men. . . Please.

Do not take this the wrong way here. Repenting from the Doctrines of men is not a salvation issue. You are all still God's people, his chosen. But it is a request from God so you can be prepared for the end of times, and the kingdom of God on Earth.
