

Christianity Is Jewish

Let us pray.

BAR-CHU et Adonai ham'vorach. Baruch Adonai ham'vorach l'olam vaed. Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha-olam, asher bacher banu mi-kol ha'amim, v'natan lanu et Torato. Baruch Atah, Adonai, notein ha Torah.

BLESS ADONAI who is blessed. Blessed is Adonai who is blessed now and forever. Blessed are You, Adonai, our God, Sovereign of the universe, who has chosen us from among the peoples, and given us the Torah. Blessed are You, Adonai, who gives the Torah.

Isaiah 40:3 A voice of one calling in the wilderness, "Prepare the way for the Lord".

We are in the very last of days before the coming of Messiah. These are the days of preparation. And it is of utmost importance in these days of preparation that we get our hearts and minds focused correctly on who our brothers are. So, I speak to both Jews and Christians together and I say that you are brothers. You are all God's people.

Afterall Christianity is not another religion separate from Judaism. That is an incorrect teaching of man. Christianity is Jewish. When someone receives Jesus into their heart they become a Christian and Christians are adopted sons of Abraham.

Galations 3:29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

How does this work? It works because of who Jesus is. We look back to the prophet Jeremiah, "This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God and they will be my people." (Jeremiah 31:33)

Then we look to John. In the beginning was the Word and Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1) The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

The Word was the Torah and the Torah became flesh and this was Jesus. Jesus was and is the living Torah and so as we accept Jesus into our hearts we accept the Torah and it is written on our hearts and put into our minds. As Christians follow Jesus, they follow Torah.

Galations 4:4-7 But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship. Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father". So, you are no longer a slave, but God's child, God has made you also an heir.

Christians and Jews follow Torah. Christians and Jews are God's people. Christians and Jews are brothers, and we should all start acting as such. Christians will say, the Jew's need to be saved by Jesus, and the Jews will say the Christians don't follow Torah and have rejected the law. To the Christians I will say this, Jesus is choosing his bride and not all of God's people will be chosen to be part of his bride. And the Jews were chosen by God to be his people before Jesus came and they are his people forever. To the Jews I

will say, Christians follow their heart and by doing so they cannot help but follow Torah since Christ is the Living Torah. And God has accepted them as his adopted sons and so must you accept them as brothers.

If this is confusing to you then pray for wisdom and the Spirit will unfold it to you because it is truth. In these days of preparation let us prepare our hearts to accept each other and fulfill God's promise.
